The year 2016-2017 was a significant year for us as organization rolled out a number of projects providing access to quality of education, health care, lively hood to People with Hearing Impaired (deaf community)

A major achievement in this year is increasing children strength 92 (Students). My sincere thanks to (Telangana State Government, and SOCIAL JUSTICE EMPOWERMENT Govt of India,INVESCO, ASHA FOUNDATION, SMILE FOUNDATION), Telangana Tourism Govt of TS. etc...) Who adopted the children of Orphans. Special thanks to individual supporters who helped us to make our vision become successful and giving free special education to the Very poor children with hearing disability.

We have also been reaching out to children in their ear and hearing health care and our team consciously conducting the health camps and know about the condition of health and take remedial measures.

A major achievement in this year has been providing access to free accommodation and residential facilities to children with hearing impaired from Telangana state government. This is very helpful to the children came from rural area and very poor. The most common problem for our team also to create awareness about ear care at a community level. Now we have classes up to 7th and we planned to prolong it to 10th class with residential facilities for boys and girls with hearing impaired.

Our special thanks to the government of Telangana, individual supporters, volunteers, NGO's and other philanthropic organizations to continue their support to have proper atmosphere for children with hearing impaired. For this we need a own building for residential facilities to reach a higher goals in special education and services to the deaf community. I would like to express my gratitude to all our staff, donors and volunteers whose combined efforts have given more confidence to take new challenges.

About PHIN

PHIN is an organization which has been working for the development of hearing impaired persons in the fields of Education, health, human rights and Job oriented programs. Apart from that it has been giving an idea about sign language to the Parents, teachers, employees and to the general public and has been independently working for the hearing impaired persons rights in the Government activities. By these activities we have been recognized for our service by government of India and had been awarded with National awards for two times (Helen Keller National Award in the year 2007, Role model National Award in the year 2013) and also have been awarded with so many state level awards.

Due to the negligence of the previous governments the hearing impaired persons did not develop because there were no facilities like communication, special teachers and special education material for the development of the hearing impaired persons. To solve above problems Mrs. Vujjini Janaki has started PHIN organization in the year of 2007 and helping the hearing impaired persons in their overall development by conducting different types of activities.

PHIN activities

1) Exploring the Education right from village level to state level to the hearing impaired people and make deaf children to go school who are not going and who are dropped out.

2) Organizing Training activities for deaf people from village level to state level

3) Conducting free marriages for hearing impaired people and also has been running free marriage Bureau.

4) Helping the deaf people for judicial affairs in the Courts and Police stations by sending the Sign language interpreters.

5) Providing job opportunities for the hearing impaired people in Government and private organizations with the collaboration of the State and Central governments with PSU's.

6) PHIN has been providing free education to around 92 hearing impaired children including some orphans, abandoned children and Juvenile children.



PHIN activities in the Telangana state and achieving own state i.e. TS

For the own Telangana state we had been participating as a convener of the Persons with disability from village level to state level and conducted so many events like Rasta roko's, Dharnas, Hunger strikes, Million march and Chalo Delhi in all over Telangana districts.

About PHIN – Residential School for Hearing Impaired

Reasons for Establishment of PHIN residential school

There are nearly 6 Lakh hearing impaired people in 10 districts of Telangana state. But there are only 3 government schools for this people in all over Telangana state. They are located at Karimnagar, Miryalaguda and Hyderabad. These are not sufficient for the population of deaf children. Due to lack of comfortable atmosphere in the schools for deaf we started PHIN hearing impaired Residential school in a Rented house at Sripuram colony, Malakpet in the year 2014. Sri G.Devi Prasad, TNGO Central Union President had attended as a chief guest for the Helen Keller's Birth anniversary which was conducted by us on June 27, in the year 2014. He observed our service activities towards for the deaf people and recommended our plea to the Telangana state honorable Chief minister Sri. Kalvakuntla Chandra shekar rao. ON observing our genuine plea our honorable CM pleased and ordered the concerned officials to provide a free residential quarter to run our office and school. As a result we have been provided quarter numbers Ms71 & 72. There are only two schools for hearing impaired girls with hostel facility in all over Telangana state. Parents could not pay high Fees for private schools so that they could not give better education for their hearing impaired children. To this type of people we have started a Residential school and providing free education.

Mrs. V.janaki has been assisting the people with disability since 1997. So, Indian Government had recognized her assistance and had given Helen Keller award in 2007. Since then, we have taken Helen Keller as our role model and conducting Helen Keller's birthday celebrations at our PHIN School. And also V.Janki had been awarded with Role model award by the Indian government for the service from 2007 to 2013. We have got many awards from the state government and other NGO's but still we are not happy because there is no comfortable atmosphere for hearing impaired people in the fields of Education, health and Job oriented organizations. We would be happy when this people get equal rights on a par with normal people in every field and everywhere in Telangana state.

In our PHIN hearing impaired Residential school we have been providing free education to poor, orphan and street children. And also we have been organizing so many social service activities and helping deaf people in their education and health and other programs like freely arranging marriages and all important International Day's.



Talent Enhancement

Drawing

Children at PHIN have special talent in drawing. They have participated in different competetions and won many prizes. We too encourage the students in not only education but also in co-curricular activities like drawing, sports and games.

Speech Therapy

We have special equipments go give speech therapy to those who can listen at high decibels. We put maximum effort to make them to speak few words.

Yoga

At PHIN children regularly do yoga in the morning and sometimes in the evening for one hour. It consist of meditation, breathing and physical exercises.

Community Outreach

- 1) Capacity willing to the volunteers on rights and entitlements and HIV prevention.
- 2) Environmental and sanitation awareness program.
- 3) Medical camps and AID's and appliances
- 4) Rally's with volunteers and PSW's
- 5) Rehabilitation and counseling to the girls children.
- 6) Training program on Right to education act UNCRPD and PWD's act.
