RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL



Education for Children with Hearing Impairment.

The objectives of

creating educational opportunities for the children with hearing impairment has been taken up by the people with Hearing Impaired Network -PHIN by the establishment of Residential School in the center of the City at Hyderabad. Since inception, the school has benefited more than 200 children. This Year 69 boys and 78 girls totaling to 147 Orphan and semi orphan children with hearing impairment are getting access the quality education in child friendly environment.

The trained and experienced teachers at the school are engaged in innovative teaching methodologies to enhance the learning levels of children. Apart from this, recreational and literary activities such as cultural performance, drawing and painting competitions being organized at the school by the volunteers from corporate organizations and individuals has been a respite for the children in the school.

COMPUTER TRAINING;

BRIDGING DIGITAL DIVIDE AMONG CHILDREN WITH HEARING IMPAIRMENT.



Computers, Tablets and smartphones can be used to enhance listening for people with some degree of loss. It does not aim to be comprehensive but provides a useful introduction to some of the key assistive technology available. Generally, as hearing loss gets progressively worse, difficulties in communicating increase. People with milder hearing losses may struggle when there are some background noise and people with more severe hearing loss may not be able to manage even in very quiet environments.

Wherein in the current context computer knowledge has become a pre-requisite for any employment and getting acquainted with this knowledge and training for the people with hearing impairment was a challenge. The intervention of PHIN to train the young people with hearing impairment at its premises with the support of Global

Data Works. A total of 15 candidates were trained in 3 batches each consists of 5 members. The courses were MS Office with internet concepts and computer language.

MEDICAL CAMPS:



PHIN used to conduct health camps for its children at least twice in a year in the school premises. On 1-7-2023, on the occasion of Doctor's Day, the Doctors in the medical camp arranged at school premises, conducted routine health checkup followed by diagnosing any alignments and diseases among the children and provide them with medicines and referrals for advanced treatments for a total of 147 children and 28 staff members.

Child centric approach has been followed by the instructors which not only building strong relationship between the teacher and the student but also enhancing the learning levels of children.

They are very happy to hear the same. They came to Hyderabad on 1-10-2022. The PHIN School handed over the girl Swapna to her grandmother in the presence of Child Welfare Committee members. The grandmother and maternal uncle conveyed they`re thanks to PHIN School for looking after the girl for so many years as their own daughter.

Since then, she is staying and studying in the Residential School for People with hearing impaired Network. Now she is in **9th class**. The PHIN school approached the AADHAR Centre in the Metro Station at Moosarambagh to take an Aadhar Card for this Girl. There through her Fingerprints it came to light that she is native of Pedda Vanchela (V) Palasa Mandal of Srikakulam District, Andhra Pradesh. The PHIN School contacted the phone Number in the Aadhar card and the mother and grandmother (Nagamani & Kanthamma) of the girl came in contact and they are informed about their daughter missed about 10 years back. They are very happy to hear the same. They came to Hyderabad along with A.P. Police to take their daughter back. The PHIN Residential School handed over the girl Durga to her mother/grandmother in the presence of Police and Child Welfare Committee members. The mother and grandmother conveyed they're thanks to PHIN School for looking after the girl for so many years as their own daughter.
