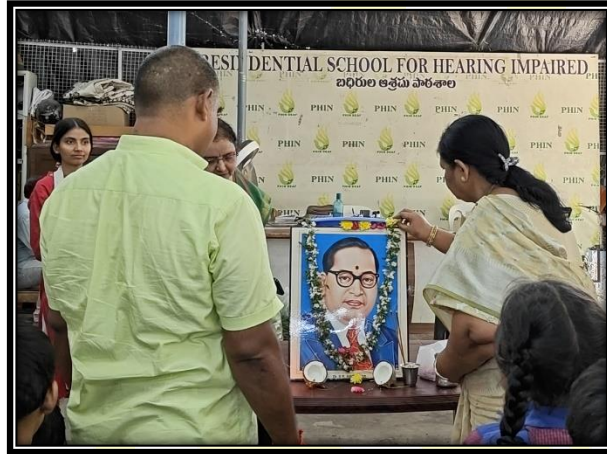

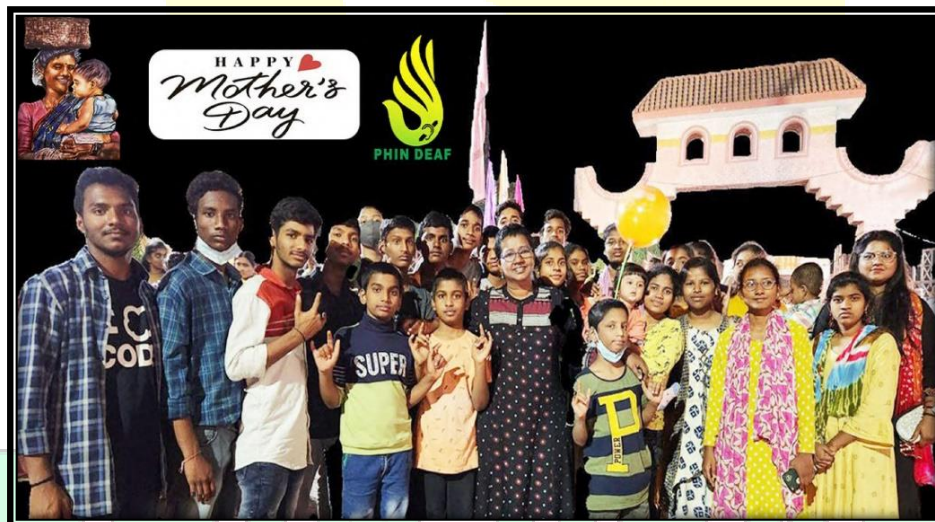
"Honouring the Legacy of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar"
